Minutes of General Meeting 9th February

“ Secretary’s Note: *Comments made above may not reflect accurately points discussed at the AHMF AGM or that there was a consensus by the state delegates’ present on views put forward by the Australian Historic Vehicle Interest Group.*

Australian Historic Vehicle Interest Group has never had any formal communication with the FHMC SA on any topic. The structure of the group, their charter and who they actually represent has never been clearly stated.”

Log Books and Conditional Registration:

Signing of Log Books extract of letter from DPTI

Point 3.6 of the Code states in part:

*3.6 Vehicle owners must ensure records for each journey undertaken in a conditionally registered vehicle are listed in the log book issued by the recognised motor vehicle club. The date of the journey and a brief description of the journey must be recorded **before** each journey commences.*

Whilst this part does not reference ‘signing’, the next part states:

The driver must also sign the book (next to the particulars of use) before each journey commences.

Point 3.7 of the Code further states:

3.7 A journey for the purposes of log book recording may consist of one or more separate trips. However a journey that commences at 10.00pm on a particular day and finishes at 2:00am the next day constitutes two calendar days, as each day commences at midnight. Consequently, two separate days use must be recorded in the log book.

So from reading the above the only person who is required to sign the log book is the actual driver at the commencement of the “journey”. As a journey may consist of one or more separate trips it would appear the provided one entry is made in the log book at the commencement of the journey and signed by the driver at the time this all that is required.

I can also advise that the wording relating to log book entries has been noted for any future review of the Code of Practice and will be altered to make the requirement clearer in the future.

EFT payments for Log Book orders

Some clubs are paying by EFT (good) but placing a manual order (not so good) as there can be a up to 10 working days between receipt of the EFT and the posted order it a 'tad confusing on who has ordered what. Currently we have payments BUT no orders. If possible please order of the web site if paying by EFT – Thank You
