General Business

Advertising up and coming events.

With the deletion of the Club Notes Section from the Motoring Section of the Advertiser (3 years ago) a Club has submitted a proposal that the Federation investigates a scheme whereby the club notes section is resumed with financial support from all affiliated clubs via the Federation with a suggestion that the motor trade be approached by the Advertiser to contribute by way of advertising.

I had discussions with an experienced advertising person re the suggestion of placing an “Ad in the motoring section of club events” – A: Would not be a cheap exercise, costing would depend on the size of the block, a block could be booked on a permanent basis which would reduce the cost – how big would be the first criteria – when all the parameters are set a cost could then be negotiated. Next question would be who would be responsible for ensuring the content was received on time etc. Their suggestion was, “if all the club wants to do is advise members of an event, use the General Notices section in the Advertiser – most cost effective method.

Discussion among delegates present, highly unlikely that any club would use it given the options available via electronic media. *"Federation not to proceed with proposal"*

"We must change our habits"

Patrick Rollet, president of the Federation Internationale des Vehicules Anciens (FIVA), believes a change in mindset by FIVA and classic owners can future-proof the hobby for the next 50 years

In a Q&A posted online in April Rollet called on clubs to embrace technology to reach a new and younger audience. "Many clubs ostracise youngtimers, both vehicles and members," he said. "We must change our habits: create a 'young section' in the clubs, run by a younger person, to design simple, dynamic and fun outings.

"It's vital that we avoid being too narrow in our definition of historic motoring," he added. "You might only be interested in vintage Bentleys, but please don't criticize your neighbor's passion for mopeds, or microcars, or buses, or customized American muscle cars in fuchsia with turquoise stripes. They're all an important part of our history, our culture, and rich diversity of classic vehicles on our roads. Beware the risk of seeming elitist, when young people often want to own a historic vehicle simply because it is different: quirky, unique, even iconoclastic.
