Following Motions were put to the Delegates

“A scheme for Grants to member clubs be approved for the period 1st September 2020 to 30th June 2021 on accordance with clause 10.4 of the Constitution”

“A Junior Grant to member clubs be approved for the period 1st December 2020 to 30th June 2021 on accordance with clause 10.4 of the Constitution”

Both motions were moved, seconded and carried.

A full copy of the criteria for the grants has been sent to all clubs

Log Books and Conditional Registration

Running smoothly, orders can be delayed due to time frame between club placing the order via the web-site and the payment arriving in the mail, EFT is the quickest and easiest way to make the payment. E.g. EFT was processed on the 26th June but to date no order has been received!

From the inception of the scheme until June 2017 we had issued approx. 90,000 Log Books, since 1st July 2017 we have issued 43,000 books

Arthur Clisby Picnic Day
