Registration requirements on changing car clubs

As you know conditional registration for the purpose of the Historic, Individually Constructed, Left-hand drive and Street Rod vehicles (the Scheme), relies on the vehicle owner being a financial member of a recognised car club. At the time of making application with Service SA to join the Scheme, the vehicle owner must present a MR334 application form which is completed by an authorised person within the nominated car club, nominating the vehicle for the Scheme and confirming the applicant is a financial member.

In the scenario where the vehicle owner moves clubs, a new MR334 is to be completed by the new club and then presented to Service SA. This is to confirm the vehicle owner is a financial member and nominating the vehicle to use the Scheme.

System-wise, Service SA must cancel the existing registration which is affiliated with the old club and take out a new registration period nominating the new club for which the vehicle owner is now a financial member with.

Our Registration and Licensing System does not allow a vehicle that is currently nominated for the Scheme to change the car club the owner is a member of. The only way our system can affiliate the vehicle with a car club for the Scheme is at the time of granting registration.

ICV Certificates

The issue is that ICVs get issued with a Certificate by Vehicle Standards (section 163AA). In the past these Certificates certified that the vehicle as a one-off build (made no mention of ICV). Now the Certificates certify that the vehicle is an ICV (and not a one-off build). Brian wants to confirm that the references in the certificates (old – one off build and new - ICV) are the same thing.

Confirming that the Certificate of Exemptions issued under the Act for vehicles that are ICV or one-off build vehicles are one in the same. Certificate of Exemptions previously issued with the reference of 'one-off build' will be treated in the same manner as a newer Certificate of Exemption issued with the reference of ICV. There is no requirement for any existing Certificate of Exemption issued with the reference as 'one-off build' to be issued a replacement Certificate of Exemption specifically stating ICV.

Federation Motorfest (Shirley Tonkin)
