## **7. General Business:**

- a. The passing of Gordon Cowley and Geoff Chase was mentioned. Geoff’s memorial is for Friday 11.30 at Centennial Park and Gordon’s the same day at 12.45 pm at Enfield. Gordon was Secretary of the Federation for two years and Geoff always attended Motorfest events every year with Cynthia and Dodge.
- b. The Constitution change was queried and the advice to update Expulsion and Suspension (Section 40 of the Act) was read out to members and was requested that they be put in the minutes for clubs when updating their Constitution =
- a. Subject to giving a member an opportunity to be heard or to make a written submission, the committee may resolve to expel a member upon a charge of misconduct detrimental to the interests of the association.
- b. Particulars of the charge shall be communicated to the member at least one month before the meeting of the committee at which the matter will be determined.
- c. The determination of the committee shall be communicated to the member, and in the event of an adverse determination the member shall, (subject to 5.5d below), cease to be a member 14 days after the committee has communicated its determination to the member.
- d. It shall be open to a member to appeal the expulsion to the association at a general meeting. The intention to appeal shall be communicated to the secretary or public officer of the association within 14 days after the determination of the committee has been communicated to the member.
- e. In the event of an appeal under 5.5d above, the appellant’s membership of the association shall not be terminated unless the determination of the committee to expel the member is upheld by the members of the association in general meeting after the appellant has been heard by the members of the association, and in such event membership will be terminated at the date of the general meeting at which the determination of the committee is upheld.
- c. Federation Tour

David gave an outlined of the tour from 16<sup>th</sup> May to 24<sup>th</sup> May 2026. The program was sent out to interested people and will go on the website. Please email David if you are interested. Bookings for accommodation have been done and a launch will happen later. Confirm ASAP.

d. Information from the DIT meeting.

Keep MR334 forms for 5 years.

DIT will be providing a check list in the future which will go out to Service SA centres for references to historic vehicles.

LHD vehicles – a list of approved vehicles needs confirmation

DIT Vehicle Standards Manager is Lesley Emmett.

A vehicle must be running not trailered to go to Regency Park for inspection

To turn back a speedo – apply for a certificate from Consumer Affairs.

Engine number need not be on a MR334 form providing it shows a vin or chassis number.

Vin plates or chassis numbers for car and motorbikes only applies after 1989.

A Will must show vehicle/s as well as number plate/s

e. Recent changes to the secondhand motor vehicle Act shows that up to four vehicles may be sold in a year or you need a licence to sell vehicles.
